Bids must be plainly marked **BLACK FORK COMMONS RESTROOM PROJECT**. Bids must contain the full name and address of every person or firm interested in same and be accompanied by a performance bid bond or certified check in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid payable to the City of Shelby, Ohio, as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and its performance properly secured. Should any bids be rejected, said check will be returned to the bidder upon the proper execution of a contract. The Project shall be completed within the time specified in the Information to Bidders after the execution of the Contract.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Richland County and the City of Shelby, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division, (614) 644-2239.

The City cannot award a bid to a contractor if the bid is above the Engineer's Estimate. The City of Shelby will entertain no bids of any person or firm in default to the City of Shelby, Ohio, and reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
